PHDCCI'S 7TH GLOBAL FILM TOURISM

CONCLAVE HIGHLIGHTS CINEMA'S ROLE IN BOOSTING TOURISM

he 7th Global Film Tourism Conclave, organized by the PHD Chamber of Commerce and Industry (PHDCCI) in collaboration with the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India, highlighted the impact of films on global tourism. Held at Radisson Blu Mumbai International Airport, the event, themed 'Reel to Real: Redefining Destinations,' explored destination branding, government incentives, and cinematic storytelling as drivers of tourism.

Chief Guest Mr. Prithul Kumar, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, emphasized that every dollar spent on international film production in India generates sixfold economic benefits. He reaffirmed the government's commitment to policy reforms and industry collaboration to position India as a global film tourism hub.

Supported by Gujarat Tourism, Madhya Pradesh Tourism, and Uttar Pradesh Tourism, the Conclave featured engaging discussions among industry leaders. Mr. Sabbas Joseph, Co-Founder of Wizcraft Group, highlighted how the International Indian Film Academy Awards (IIFA) have significantly boosted tourism in host cities. With IIFA 2025 set for Jaipur, the event is expected to generate substantial tourist interest.

Mr. Shibasish Sarkar, President, Producers Guild of India & Group CEO, Reliance Entertainment Studios, outlined the evolution of film tourism over three decades, discussing technological advancements, audience trends, and policy changes that have shaped the industry. He also presented a roadmap for India's leadership in global film tourism.

The panel discussion 'Shoot to Bill, Tourist Dollars,' moderated by Ms. Reema Lokesh, featured industry experts,

including Mr. Prithul Kumar and Ms. Lohita Sujith from the Motion Picture Association India Office. They highlighted India's 30% incentive for foreign film productions, which has led to a 25% increase in international shoots over two years.

A masterclass on 'Availing Government Incentives for Shooting in India,' led by Ms. Shruti Rajkumar, Vice President (I&B Desk), India Cine Hub, provided valuable insights into policies, tax

rebates, and incentives from Invest India and various state governments.

State-focused sessions, 'Filming in Madhya Pradesh: The Heart of Incredible India' and 'Filming in Gujarat: Rann of Opportunities,' showcased how these states leverage scenic landscapes, cultural heritage, and financial incentives to attract filmmakers.

The session 'Lights, Camera, Destination: Creating Experiences that Inspire Travel' explored film-friendly infrastructure and storytelling in tourism. Experts, including

'Cinematic ROI: Unveiling the Economics of Film Tourism' examined successful global revenue models inspired by film tourism. Representatives from Roy Kapur Films, Dharma Productions, and international stakeholders deliberated on creating a sustainable economic framework for India, taking inspiration from film tourism initiatives in the UK and Ireland. With PHDCCI reaffirming its

 What were all the efforts that had been put in by the school to be recognized as the World's Best School for Environmental Action?

"Environment The vision Sustainability" by our founder chairman Dr. A.F. Pinto has been a strong forum since the inception of the Ryan Group of Institutions in 1976 and has strived to create and nourish a strong bond with the environment. Be it plantation of saplings, creating small gardening patches, water conservation, combatting change...the climate list commendable. Today it acts like a voice of conscience gently yet firmly nudging all Ryanites towards sustainable green practices.

Ryan International School, Vasant Kunj nurtures environmental awareness through a carefully designed curriculum. Students, teachers and parents of the school collaboratively contribute toward its success. Water-harvesting; solar panels for electric supply; plantation drives; enhancing awareness of flora and fauna; use of only eco-friendly material on the campus; Hydroponic unit, Bioflock Club, vermicompost plant, Biogas plant,

the three-Rs of reduce, reuse and recycle as the mainstay of all policy decisions, are some of our green initiatives and practices. The school has also undertaken the Environment Sustainability project D.A.B.A.T. to actively involve students in finding solutions to environmental issues using technology.

Inspired by the benefits of 'Going Green' impact addressing and its on environmental challenges and building a more sustainable future, a formidable team of Ryanites from Ryan International School, Vasant Kunj, New Delhi named 'Acquifier Guardians' unleashed their creativity and scientific thinking at the Climate Change Challenge held at COP28, the United Nations Climate Conference in Dubai to emerge as the Climate Change Champions with their topic "Mitigating the Effects of Water Scarcity" embodying the very spirit of the school: Conservation of the Environment Awareness and spreading about Sustainable Development Goals. The team was guided throughout their journey by the vision of Chairman Sir Dr. A.F. Pinto and Managing Director Madam Dr. Grace Pinto of being the leaders and Change makers of tomorrow. Our team dedicated teachers has instrumental in guiding students at every step of this Green Journey.

The global competition was launched by Burjeel Holdings and Said Business School to find solutions to the climate crisis through education, innovation, and forward-thinking. Acquifier Guardians had to pass a gruelling 5-step challenge to emerge as winners from 600 teams, 8000 students, and 43 participating countries.

The rippling effect of this extraordinary global recognition at COP 28 together with leading various green initiatives both at the school and the community level was catalytic in Ryan International School, Vasant Kunj being recognised as the winner of the World's Best School Prizes (2024) by T4 Education for Environmental Action.

More needs to be done at both the individual and collective levels! The vision of our founder mentors Chairman Sir Dr. A.F. Pinto and Managing Director Madam Dr. Grace Pinto acts as our guiding force strengthening our efforts to save the environment. Their constant guidance and support have helped Ryan Vasant Kuni achieve this global recognition and acknowledgment as the Best School in the Environment Category.

· What makes your school different from others?

Ryan Vasant Kunj incepted in 1991 is one of the leading K 12 educational institutions having a strength of over 3000 students mentored by more than 120 educators. The school stands out as a premier Educational Institute in Delhi for many of its unique features.

Ryan Vasant Kunj promotes itself as an exemplar of sustainable development. Water harvesting, solar panels for electric supply, tree plantation drives, use of ecofriendly material on campus, enhancing awareness of flora and fauna on the campus, the three Rs of reduce, recycle and reuse as the mainstay of all policy decisions make the school an ecofriendly school.

The school celebrates Environment Week every July to engage students in environmental action. During Environment Week students are involved in various environment-friendly activities. They also take out marches, cleanliness drives, and plantation drives to spread awareness about environment conservation in the community. The school has already planted more than 5000 saplings around Delhi. Ryan Vasant Kunj has strived to integrate environment conservation and sustainable practices into subjects like art, music, dance, and the core subjects so that students think. and act on environmental concerns. For e.g., every time we have a guest visiting the school, we have a tree plantation ceremony where the guest leaves a green footprint by planting a sapling to the melodious singing of the environment song. The students have various implemented environmental projects like Hydroponics, Drip Irrigation, D.A.B. A.T., vermicomposting, and Biogas to list a few.

The efforts of Ryan International School, Vasant Kunj in championing environmental sustainability and stewardship received global recognition when the school was, honoured as the winner of the esteemed World's Best School Prize for Environmental Action 2024.

Inculcating values in students forms a very important part of the curriculum at Ryan. Every Ryanite begins his or her day in school by attending the morning assembly. The assembly is based on the values of the month like compassion, tolerance, respect, etc. The class on duty explains the value through enactments, dialogues, music, and dance. Also, it is a wonderful opportunity for students to come on stage and discover their talents.

The school focuses on innovative pedagogy to achieve its vision of academic excellence. Innovative pedagogies include new. original. advanced, and forward-looking practices that help the teacher and student assess the quality and quantity of learning. The teachers employ different teaching styles based on Howard Gardner's principle of multiple intelligence to help students with different cognitive abilities learn effectively. Teachers employ play way method to make learning fun for students. For e.g., marking attendance is turned into a vocabulary game where each student is given a unique word that he speaks out loud instead of saving the normal yes/no. Thus a classroom of 40 learners learn 40 new words and build their vocabulary. These words can be replaced with new words every month. At Ryan learning extends beyond the walls of the classroom as students are taken on field trips, movies, and plays to learn by observing.

The ATAL lab at Ryan is an amazing space where young Ryanites imagine, experiment, and give form to their innovative ideas and projects. The school organises Science exhibitions to enable students to showcase their innovative ideas. Ryanites participate in science exhibitions at various national and international levels to showcase their innovations and projects.

To enable students to compete in a global world students actively participate in Olympiads and other examinations **like NTSE** to keep the competitive spirit among students alive.

The school is proud of its technological strides in implementing the Ryan School OS which enables it to communicate with parents and students on all aspects of learning and school curriculum. Also, it helps to continue online learning in case of sudden contingency.

The school adopts an interdisciplinary approach to learning and offers specialized learning through various courses such as astronomy, robotics, and STEM.

The Ryan vision of holistic development of its students has helped students participate in various co-curricular activities like MUN - The Model United Nations where students emulate world diplomats to find solutions to global crises. Ryan Vasant Kunj hosted its 15th edition of RISVKMUN in 2024 which saw participation from more than 25 different schools in Delhi and NCR.

The Arts and Humanities Fest Confluence is organised annually to encourage students to compete with students from different parts of the country and celebrate creativity, ideas, and skills. Discovery is the Annual Science Fest to bring together intelligent minds to find innovative ideas for problems.

A unique initiative, the Ryan Vasant Kunj launched the Ryan Schools Food Bucket Challenge to feed more than 3000 poor children. **The Mahipalpur Project** is a community transformation initiative taken up by Ryan Vasant Kunj with a vision to empower the suburban area in Vasant Kunj towards spheres like Education, Environment, Health, and Economic enhancement.

Students with special needs appearing for the Board exams are provided with extra classes, scribes, and extra time.
